Soccer Open Play Rules

1. Cincinnati Sports Club members may enjoy Open Play for no cost; it is a membership benefit.
2. Non-members may participate at no cost for the remainder of the 2009-year. However, they must check in at Member Services and sign a waiver. Failure to do so will result in the player being asked to leave.
3. All players [CSC members and non-members] must receive and wear a wristband. Wristbands are available at the Check-In Desk or Member Service Desk inside the Sports Club lobby.
4. No more than 7 players per team on the field at one time.
5. Teams should call/referee their own games. Teams should use the scoreboard to keep score. Security will turn on scoreboard.
6. There is a 22:30 time limit per game. The clock does not stop; it runs continuously. New players may join a game already in progress as long as both teams agree.
7. After each game, the winning team may stay on the field to play in the next game. If there is another full team waiting to play, the losing team sits out the next game.
8. As individuals arrive at Open Play, they should sign in on the dry erase board. Players will be permitted to play in the order they arrived.
9. The Cincinnati Sports Club is a family club; inappropriate behavior and language will not be tolerated.
